



2009-2010 Dual Enrollment and Early Admission Checklist

- [] Meet with your high school counselor to determine eligibility, receive recommendation from your school, and discuss appropriate coursework. Criteria include a score of 23 or higher on the ACT or a score of 1550 (includes writing) or higher on the SAT *and* a GPA of 3.3 in academic courses.
- [] If recommendation is approved by the high school, have the following documents signed by the appropriate high school personnel:
 - A. FGCU Authorization Form – with recommended courses
 - B. Instructional Materials Form (available from the high school if your school has a signed agreement with FGCU, ex. Book Waiver form)
- [] Submit your application to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. **Be sure to include all the following completed documents:**
 - Completed FGCU application form
 - Official high school transcript
 - Official SAT or ACT scores (may be on the transcript)
 - Completed school forms (see A and B above)
 - Documentation of immunity against MMR (measles, mumps, rubella), Meningitis and Hepatitis B [meningitis and hepatitis](#).
- [] After you have been admitted, the Office of First Year Advising will contact you in order to schedule your classes. Students requesting a math course *may* need to take a math placement test. **Immunization documentation must be on file with the Student Health Services Dept. prior to registration.**
